- Locating and exposing buried fiber optical and copper facilities. Perform maintenance and splicing as needed.
- Construction and maintenance of new and existing fiber and copper facilities.
- Report and perform work in a safe and timely manner.
- Work independently in the field with attention to detail.
- Ability to operate and work on heavy equipment.
- Handle confidential information appropriately.
- Understands and interprets standard telecommunication wiring color codes and installation practices.
- Comprehends all staking and construction documents including, but not limited to, cut maps, staking sheets, right-of-way, and permitting.
- Install aerial cable using bucket truck and/or ladders.
- Terminate, splice and test fiber optic cables utilizing appropriate equipment.
