Valley has secured a \$45 million loan from USDA Rural Utilities Service (RUS) to upgrade 90% of its Cooperative Service territory to fiber Internet. The Valley Cooperative territory spans Southwest New Mexico and Southeastern Arizona encompassing 16 communities.
