- 2. Current income statement from an employer or paycheck stub;
- 3. Social Security statement of benefits;
- 4. Veterans Administration statement of benefits;
- 5. Retirement or pension statement of benefits;
- 6. Unemployment or Workers' Compensation statement of benefits.

\*If the documentation does not cover a full year, such as current pay stub, the subscriber must present the same type of documentation covering three consecutive months within the previous 12 months.
