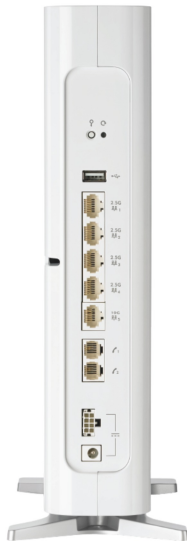

For This Process You Will Need:

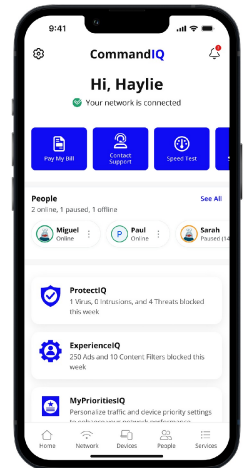
Wi-Fi 7 System

- Ethernet
- POTS Ports
- Power
- Fiber Optic SFP



Smartphone (Android or Apple) with Valley WiFi Manager App installed.

Step 1 - Locate Your Current Wi-Fi System

1a: This will be the location for your new Wi-Fi System, which is already optimally situated in your home*.

1b: Remove the power cord only from your current Wi-Fi System and unplug it from the wall socket. Do not unplug any other cables at this time.



*Should your Wi-Fi set up include an indoor network terminal, please ensure your new Wi-Fi System is separated by 2-3 feet to prevent interference with the terminal.

Step 2 - Find the Fiber Port

Please DO NOT cut any wires. This instruction sheet will show you how to disconnect and reconnect them properly so you don't do any damage to your equipment.

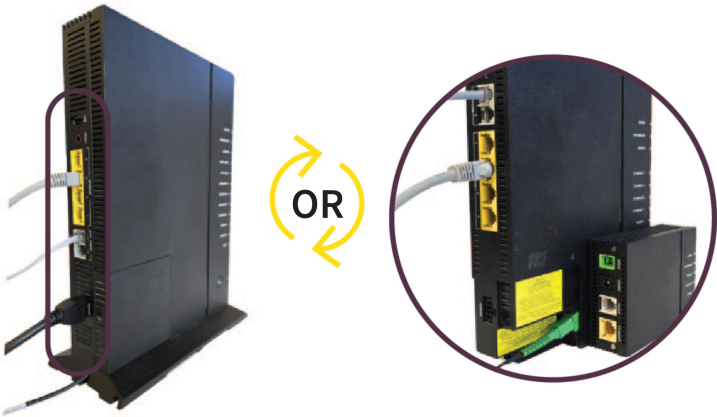

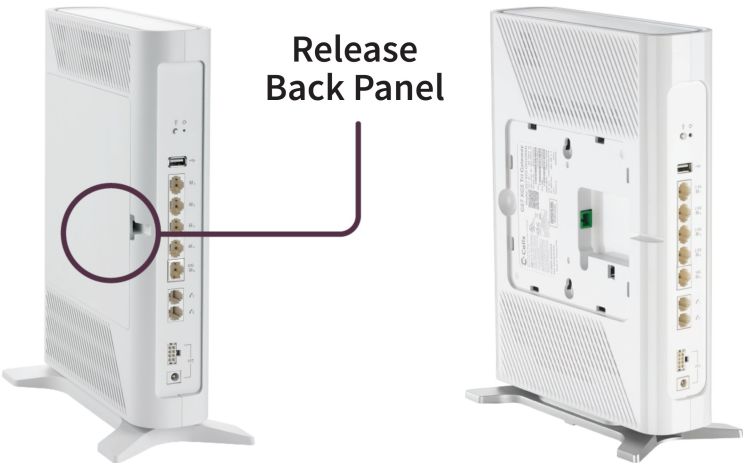
Step 3 - Note Any Remaining Cables

If you have any other cables plugged into your old router, consider taking a picture for reference. Then, unplug your remaining cables, taking care not to cut or damage them.



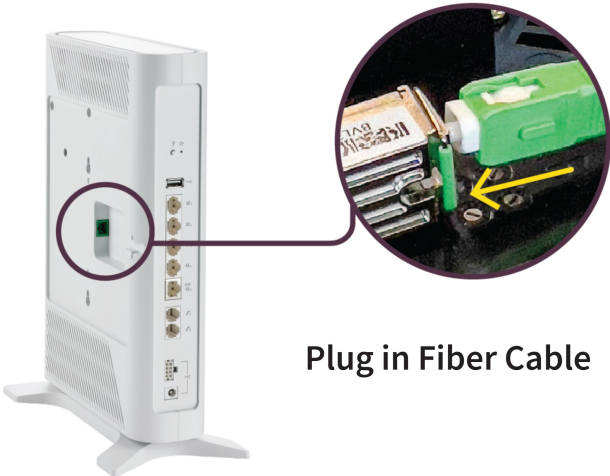
Step 4 - Remove Back Panel

In order to plug in the fiber cable, carefully remove the back panel of your new Wi-Fi system.



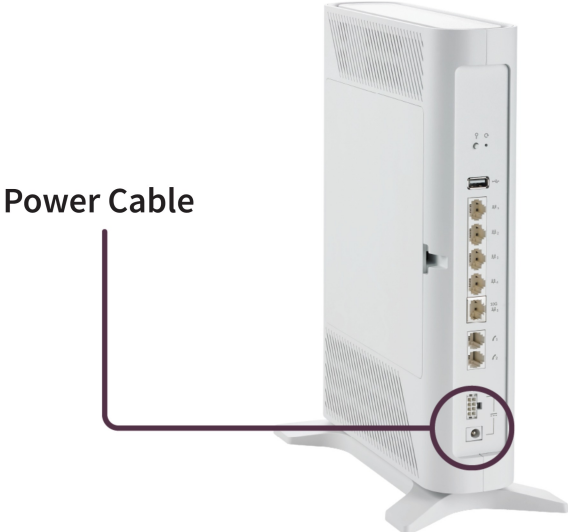
Step 5 - Plug in Required Cables

At the bottom on your new Wi-Fi system, you'll find its fiber port. Carefully snake the cable around the inside back area taking care not to bend or squeeze the fiber cable. Plug in your fiber cable. You'll hear a click when it's pushed in all the way. Ensure the fiber cable lays in the side groove before reattaching the back panel.



Step 6 - Power On and Wait 15 Minutes

Connect your new Wi-Fi system to an electrical outlet using your new white power cable. Wait 15 minutes for it to update. When finished, the light on the side should be solid blue (not blinking), and your Wi-Fi settings should be the same as your old router, including connected devices.



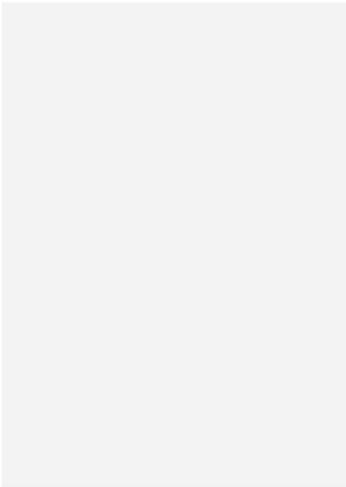
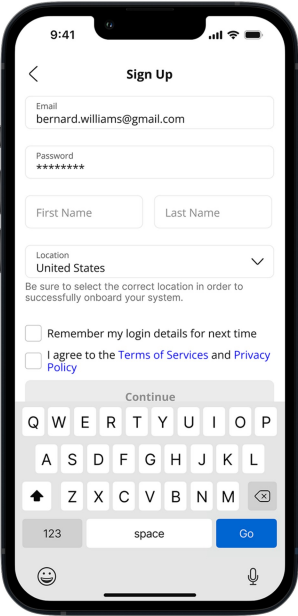
Step 7 - Set Up the Valley WiFi App

Check that your mobile phone or another Wi-Fi device is successfully connected before proceeding to download the Valley WiFi Manager App.

Download the App from the App Store or Google Play.



Once you download the Valley WiFi Manager App, follow the prompts to create an account and login.



Congratulations! You are now ready to use your new Wi-Fi System.
