Valley TeleCom Group Scholarship

Vocational Scholarship Informational Sheet

Each year the *Valley Telephone Cooperative Foundation* awards scholarships from capital credits that Valley Telephone Cooperative members have not claimed or have donated to the Foundation. Scholarships are awarded based upon the selection criteria shown below.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Applicant must be a Valley TeleCom Group customer or a child or legal dependent of the Valley TeleCom Group customer. The customer associated with the application must reside in a Valley TeleCom Group service area and have maintained active and continuous telecommunications services for at least twelve (12) months prior to the application deadline. The customer account associated with the scholarship must remain active (accounts on vacation status do not qualify) and in good standing during the application process and throughout the scholarship period.
- 2. Applicant must be in the graduating class of, or have graduated from, an accredited public, parochial, home-school, private high school, or must have obtained a G.E.D. Applicant must have plans to enter, or presently be enrolled in, a trade, technical or business school for the next year.
- 3. Applicant must maintain a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a scale of 4.0 and be a full-time student.
- 4. Applicant must complete the scholarship application in its **entirety.** The application and other required documents must be submitted electronically by Friday, February 27th, 2026. Mailed and/or Faxed copies will NOT be accepted.
- 5. Applicant must submit either a transcript or counselor certification showing their grade point average. (unofficial)
- 6. Scholarship recipients from a previous year are eligible to re-apply and will be considered along with other applicants. There is a five-year maximum for any student to receive a scholarship for vocational studies.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Selections for the Scholarship Awards each year will be based on the following criteria:

- 1. Applicant's aptitude in contemplated field of study.
- 2. High school and/or college activities, and work experience.
- 3. Community and volunteer activities.
- 4. Typed essay, as described below.
- 5. Application completeness and legibility.

The following documents must be submitted electronically by February 27th, 2026

- 1. Completed and signed Scholarship Application.
- A copy of the applicant's current transcript with cumulative grade point average or equivalent college or trade school transcript.
- 3. A current recommendation of the applicant by the principal and/or teacher of the school from which the applicant has attended.
- 4. Two letters of recommendation from an official, civic, or religious leader of the community in which the applicant resides, or an employer.
- 5. A one-page typed essay (300 words or less) containing information on what your vocational goals are and how your achievement of these goals will benefit your community.
- 6. Color Photo.
- 7. Please submit ALL documents at one time when submitting application.
